

# CANINE LIFE STAGES

## Puppies 6 – 8 Weeks of Age

- **Wellness Examination**
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Baby Teeth
- **Vaccinations:** Dhpp and Bordetella
- **Testing:** Fecal Parasite
- **Information Regarding:** Diet, House Training

## Puppies 9 – 11 Weeks of Age

- **Wellness Examination**
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Baby Teeth
- **Vaccinations:** Dhpp
- **Other Preventives:** Heartworm
- **Information Regarding:** Ear Cleaning

## Puppies 12 – 14 Weeks of Age

- **Wellness Examination**
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Baby Teeth
- **Vaccinations:** Dhpp and Bordetella
- **Other Preventives:** Flea and Tick
- **Information Regarding:** Dental Care, Exercise, Behavior, Spay/Neuter, MicroChip

## Puppies 15 – 17 Weeks of Age

- **Wellness Examination**
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Baby Teeth
- **Vaccinations:** Dhpp, Juvenile Rabies
- **Testing:** PreOperative Blood Test
- **Schedule Appointment:** Spay/Neuter

## Puppies 4 – 6 Months of Age

- **PreSurgical Examination**
- **Procedure:** Spay/Neuter, MicroChip Implant

## Puppies 16 Months to 6 Years of Age

- **Wellness Examination** (1 to 2x Annually)
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Dental Grade
- **Blood Testing:** Junior Early Detection Test
- **Dental Prophylaxis (cleaning)**
- **Other Preventives:** Heartworm, Flea & Tick
- **Vaccinations\*:** Dhpp, Bordetella, Rabies

## Dogs 7 to 20 Years of Age

- **Senior Wellness Examination** (2x Annually)
- **Evaluate:** Weight, Body Score, Dental Grade
- **Blood Testing:** Senior Early Detection Test
- **Arrhythmia, Blood & Eye Pressure Evaluation**
- **Dental Prophylaxis (cleaning)**
- **Abdominal / Thoracic Radiographs**
- **Vaccinations\*:** Dhpp, Bordetella, Rabies
